How do you locate your property lines? Before beginning any construction, you will need to locate and identify your property lines so that you can document compliance with the required setbacks. Property lines can be established by locating the property pins, which are typically a metal or synthetic rod driven into the ground. Pins can become covered over time by landscaping and other material and their location may not be readily apparent. For metal rods, a metal detector may aid in the search. If the pins cannot be located, it may be necessary to hire a surveyor to reestablish the property pins.
